## HOUSE RULES

The House Rules of the Rowing Club Ljubljana set out the rules that all members and visitors of the club follow in order to maintain a safe, tidy and pleasant space for sports and socializing. All users of the premises and outdoor areas of the Rowing Club Ljubljana are obliged to comply with these House Rules and all other rules published in the club premises or on the club's website (<https://www.vesl-klub-ljubljana.si>).

### 1. Use of Club Facilities

Users of the training rooms can enter them 15 minutes before the start of the activity. Visitors are not allowed to enter the gym, changing rooms or other training facilities during training sessions, unless agreed with the coaches or the club president.

Users carry out all activities in such a way that there is no damage to equipment and premises. Any injuries should be reported immediately to the head coach or to [info@vesl-klub-ljubljana.si](mailto:info@vesl-klub-ljubljana.si).

The basketball court is intended exclusively for practicing competitors during training.

Entry into the club premises under the influence of alcohol, drugs or stimulants is prohibited. Smoking and the use of open flames are not permitted in the club area.

Guests of the club bar are only allowed to stay in the outdoor areas belonging to the bar. Smoking is exceptionally allowed here.

Users of the training rooms leave them after completing the activities.

The entrance door in the fence is open only during the implementation of club activities. The last one to leave the premises must close them.

### 2. Taking care of equipment and premises

Members and visitors are obliged to take care of a clean and tidy environment:

1. Toilet users maintain order and cleanliness.
2. Waste is disposed of in the designated bins.

Club members participate in regular forms of cleaning and tidying up the club's premises.

Users use the club facilities, equipment and props at their own risk. Any equipment transfer is coordinated in advance with the head coach or club president.

Club equipment intended for rowing training (boats, oars, sculls, van etc) can only be used in agreement with the head coach, who schedules it and determines the allowed terms of use. In the case of purposes not related to rowing training, all club equipment may be used in agreement with the president of the club, who shall consult the head coach on this matter.

### **3. Club Area Keys**

Only active coaches, recreation managers, member competitors and persons designated by the club president have the keys to the club premises. Keys may not be copied or loaned.

When the key holder ceases to be eligible for ownership, she/he returns the key to the head coach or club president.

### **4. Use of personal vehicles, bicycles and other means of transport**

Visitors to the club can only park in the designated places so as not to block access to the club or the houses of surrounding residents. Only club vehicles and trailers and service vehicles are allowed to enter the club area by personal vehicles in agreement with the head coach or the president of the club.

Bicycles, scooters and motorcycles are left at the owner's own risk in the designated place in front of the club office.

### **5. Rules for the organization of events**

The organization of events is coordinated in advance with the member of the IO club responsible for the events. Event organizers must take care of public order, peace and safety of visitors, as well as the protection of the club's property.

Guests are allowed to use the outdoor courts and the club bar area, but no access to the hangars or pier is allowed.

After the event, the organizer makes sure that the equipment is stored and returned in the condition it was in before the event. The organizer inspects all used premises together with a member of the IO Club or a person authorized by him and takes care of the reimbursement of any damage.

## **6. Mutual relationships**

Members and visitors are expected to behave respectfully and decently, without conflict and the use of inappropriate communication. Everyone contributes to the reputation of the club through their actions.

Violent behaviour, insulting others and any physical confrontation are prohibited.

## **7. Liability and sanctions**

Violations of the house rules or agreements, instructions based on it, are first sanctioned by a warning from the head coach. In the event of a new violation, the IO Rowing Club Ljubljana may, at the proposal of the head coach, the president of the club or on its own initiative, prohibit, temporarily or permanently, the use of the club equipment and/or access to and use of the club's premises and demand compensation for any damage.

In the event of damage caused to the club, the committer is responsible for it. If the offender cannot be determined, the damage is covered by the group of users who were present in the room at the time of the event. Minors are the responsibility of their parents or guardians.
